As we're fast approaching the regional competitions it's hard to believe that the Provincial and Nationals are just around the corner. Following up on the work that Jamie and Maureen have been doing to explore ways to expand participation in the regional competitions we have compiled the requests from the regional coordinators. Back in November we presented to the regional group and asked for their proposals to expand or introduce new competition areas for trades. We received 7 applications. Going through the details of each of them there were some items included that were out of scope for this funding (non-trades areas, lunches, give-a-ways and events in next fiscal). Below is a summary of the region, the requests and what is eligible. The ITA will be contacting each regional coordinator directly and explaining the funding to support their region this fiscal. As was explained, this one-time funding is in addition to the funding that Skills BC provides for regional competitions.

ITA will transfer the \$36,472 total funding via individual grant letters to each of the regional coordinators school district or post-secondary next month.
