2. Scenario planning – risk management and risk mitigation



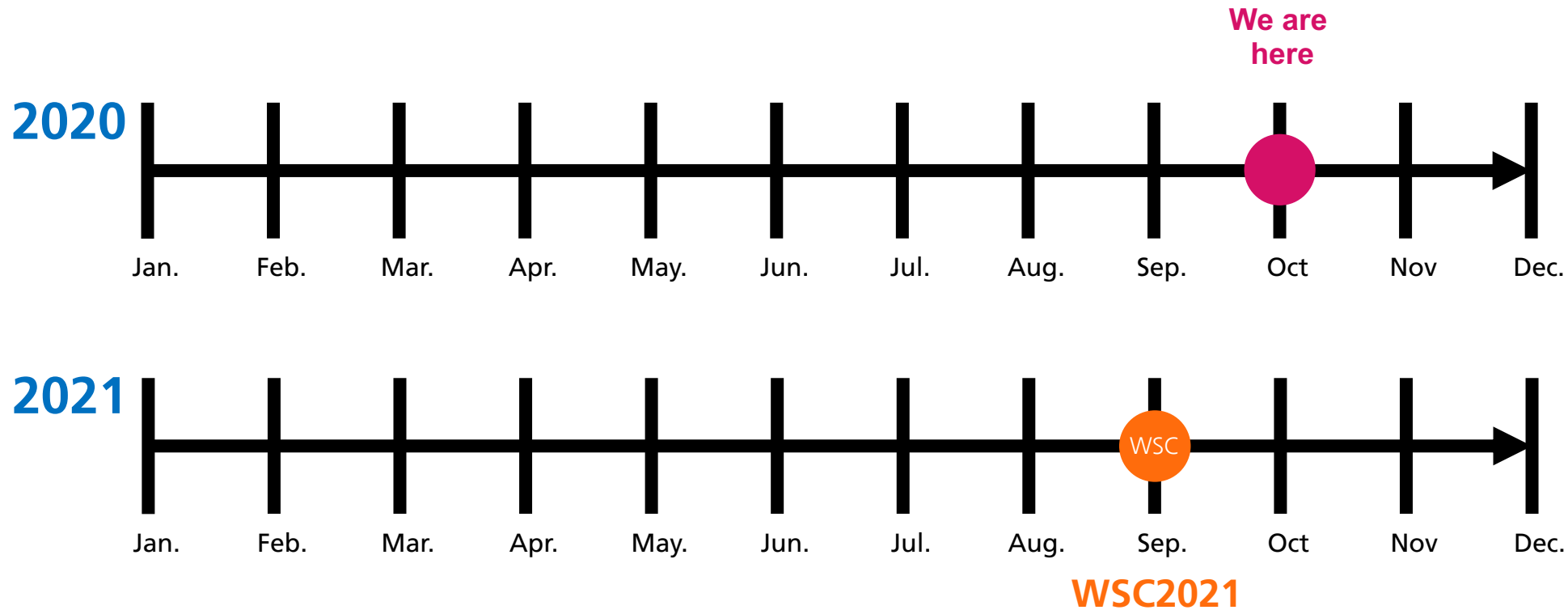
WSC2021 update

Scenarios

	Description
A	Keep as originally scheduled , i.e. 22-27 September 2021
B	Defer by a few months , e.g. move to late November 2021 (2 months)/early December 2021 (2.5 months)
C	Defer to early 2022 , e.g. January/February 2022, i.e. WSC2021/2, GA2022, WorldSkills Lyon 2023
D	Adjust WSC2021 and all future events by 1 year , i.e. WorldSkills Shanghai 2022, GA2023, WorldSkills Lyon 2024, GA2025
E	Defer WSC2021 to 2022 and keep current pattern , i.e. WorldSkills Shanghai 2022, WorldSkills Lyon 2023, GA2024
F	Cancel WSC2021 altogether, but give Shanghai 2023 and push Lyon back 2 years , i.e. GA2022, WorldSkills Shanghai 2023, GA2024, WorldSkills Lyon 2025
G	Cancel WSC2021 altogether and give Shanghai 2025 , i.e. GA2022, WorldSkills Lyon 2023, GA2024, WorldSkills Shanghai 2025
H	Cancel WSC2021 altogether, keep current event pattern , i.e. GA2022, WorldSkills Lyon 2023, GA2024, WSC2025 bid

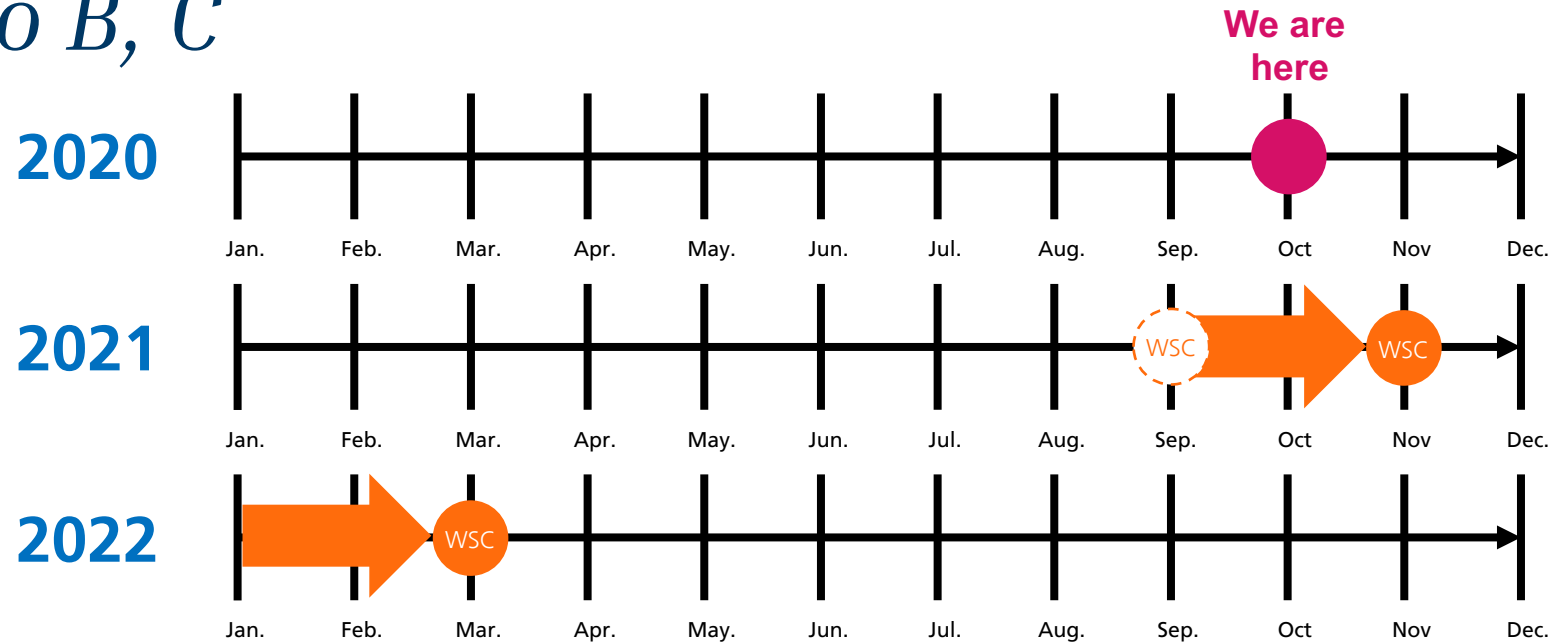

Current plan (Scenario A)



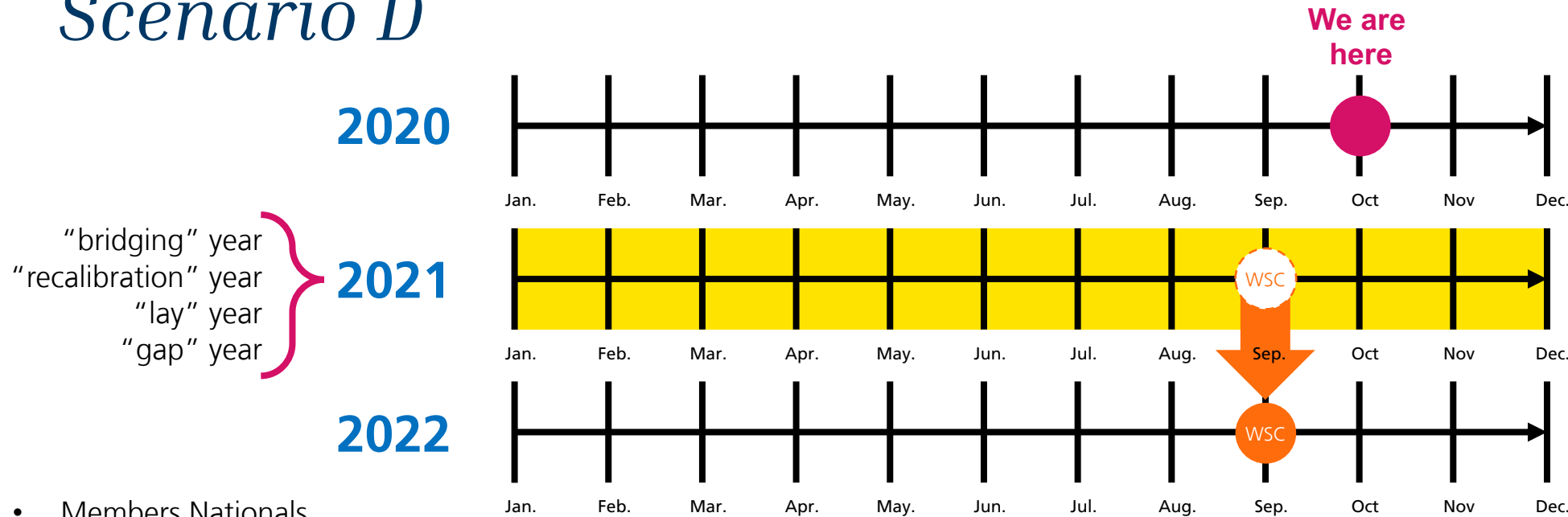
