WorldSkills Shanghai event has been moved to 2022 and WorldSkills Lyon to 2024. No dates have been announced but we expect Shanghai to be held between September and November 2022.

The competition policies and guidelines have been pushed a year including WS Provisional Registration and the age of competitors from 22 to 23 and 25 to 26 in the relevant categories.

The WS Board Terms have been extended for a year.

The Champions Trust Member Terms have been extended for a year.

The call for WS 2025 host submissions has been pushed to the fall of 2021.
