Hello all,

I want to provide you with an update on the discussions taking place internationally about WorldSkills Shanghai 2021. As you know, all members were asked to complete a survey on the eight proposed scenarios. WorldSkills (WS) compiled and presented the results this morning. Prior to the presentation of the results, the next two hosts WS China and WS France made short presentations and shared their preferred scenarios. Both organizations identified Scenario D (listed below) as their preference. Following their presentations, the first preference of members was presented with Scenario D also being the most popular choice with Scenario F (listed below) as the second choice. WS was clear that these results are important and are guiding the decisions, but all scenarios are still a possibility. The WorldSkills staff and Board will continue to analyze the full results of the member survey, gather stakeholders' feedback over the next week and a half and then the WS Board will decide when the next

WS Competition will be held. An official decision will be announced on to the membership on November 3rd.
