

# SCNC 2021 Scenario DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Given the current situation around COVID-19, this document is designed to examine different scenarios of hosting SCNC 2021. Since we did not host in 2020, it is more important than ever to host some form of the 2021 Skills Canada National Competition in order to maintain the momentum we have established with our partners and with our messaging.

### 1. SCNC 2021 SCENARIOS (See Supporting Document)

#### **All Scenarios**

Due to inconsistent provincial/territorial legislation COVID-19 travel restrictions, some P/T's may not be able to send competitors.

- What are your opinions on using a random draw to fill available participation spots?
- Potential Process: Deadline for MO to submit their participation. After the deadline, randomly selected, MOs can submit a second participant in the available skill therefore more than one competitor per skill.

#### Scenario D and E

- What are your views of only hosting post-secondary in person at SCNC 2021?
- Rationale, less liability issues with people of the age of majority and will also be easier to group participants interaction by skill area
- When can we make that decision on which scenario should be used? How long are MOs willing to wait to make that decision?
- What is your opinion of including a minimum age for participation in face to face competitions (Age of majority in QC is 18)?
- What is your opinion of using local judges if the attending NTC members cannot perform all judging duties?
- If we must limit the number of NTC members to five as an example, then we would include the following members.
  - o 1x NTC Host
  - o 1x Chair
  - o 1x Co-Chair
  - 2x Other NTC members
  - How should we select which NTC members will participate? Random? Consider regional representation? Consider NTC experience?
- Skill Bubble considerations
  - SCC to manage hotel bookings and rooming list for MO
  - Limited contact with other skill areas and staff
  - Everyone stays in single occupancy
  - SCC may be able to cost share the MO competitor hotel expenses
