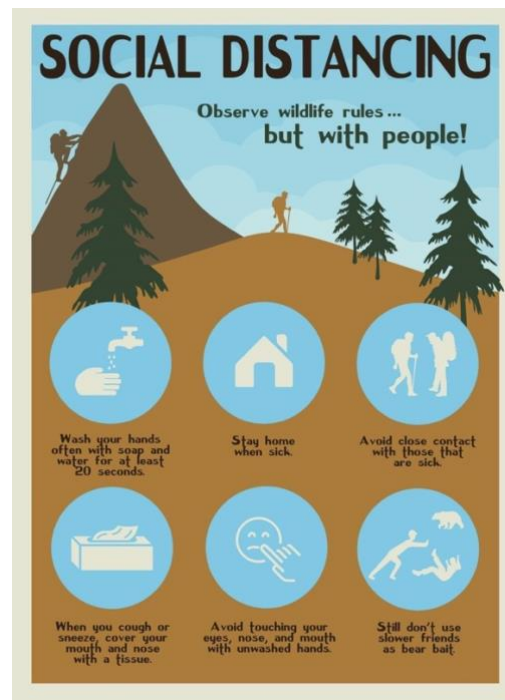




#SkillsAtHome COVID-19 Graphic Design Challenge

4. Attention to detail and artistic design is necessary
5. Send completed graphic to Skills BC in a direct message on Facebook, Twitter or Instagram before the posted deadline.
