



#SkillsAtHome Bird Feeder Challenge

Have stuff laying around the house that you could upcycle and get creative? We have a challenge for you! Make a bird feeder out of various household items, scraps and toys and put it to work in the outdoors! This is a creative activity and submissions do not have to involve woodworking or any advanced design- but can if you so desire.

This competition will have two categories: K-Grade 8 and Grades 9-12. Competitors must be students currently enrolled in B.C.

Steps to Enter:

1. Take a photo that includes you during the construction of your feeder
2. Take a close up photo of the finished product
3. Send both photos via email to info@skillscanada.bc.ca or via direct message to one of our social media accounts: Facebook, Instagram (Skills.BC), or Twitter (@SkillsBC), no later than Friday, 22 May at 12:00pm.
4. Please submit grade and school details with your photos.
5. Be as creative as you want with items found around the house; extra points for design and style!

Grade 9-12, your challenge will be to add a second level to the bird feeder.

The deadline to enter is 22 May at 12:00 pm. The winners of each level will be announced on 24 May and each will receive a \$25 gift card!
