All submissions must be received by **February 19, 2021 at 6:00 PM**. Good luck and have fun!*

#### Contest Details:

- There will be 2 age groups: Kindergarten – Grade 3 & Grade 4 – Grade 7.
- The winners of each category will receive a \$50 e-gift card.
- The deadline to enter is **February 19, 2021 at 6:00 PM**.

#### Challenge Materials:

- Standard popsicle sticks – of any color.
- Glue – hot, wood, or regular craft glue.
- Scissors – used to make minimal amounts of cuts.

#### Challenge Instructions:

- The box must be made only of popsicle sticks and glue, you may use your scissors if necessary but with minimal amounts of cuts.
- The box must have a removable lid to be made with popsicle sticks and glue but can incorporate other material (ex: a photo, additional decoration, handle/knob).
- The box must be at least one popsicle cubed (length x width x height).
- Bonus points will be rewarded for additional décor and creativity.

## Judging:

Submissions will be judged using the following criteria.

<b>Did the challenger follow the criteria given? Were there little to no cuts used? Is the lid removable? Did the challenger use any additional décor or creativity?</b>	<b>Points</b>
Failed to meet all the expectations.	0-5 points
Minimally meeting expectations.	6-10 points
Fully meeting expectations.	11-15 points
Exceeding expectations.	15-20 points
<b>BONUS</b> points may be rewarded for going above and beyond (ex: adding a knob to the lid, making the box larger than required, making compartments in the box).	<b>0-5 points</b>
