Challenge Materials:

- One fruit and one vegetable of your choice.
- Paring knife use cautiously.
- Cutting board.

Challenge Instructions:

- Find inspiration for your fruit and veggie art by researching photos, tutorials and other resources.
- Safely cut and create your own art or use a template. If creating your own template, attach the document/drawing that was used.
- Must have at least one fruit and one vegetable.
- Please attach a photo of each with your submission and a small description of what you've created.
- Bonus points may be rewarded for addressing which **Essential Skills** are being used during this project.
