Judging:

Submissions will be judged using the following criteria.

Creative design, use of the Skills Canada BC logo, neat, colorful and visually appealing	Points
Failed to meet all the expectations.	Up to 5 points
Minimally meeting expectations.	Up to 10 points
Fully meeting expectations.	Up to 15 points
Exceeding expectations.	Up to 20 points
Total amount of points that can be earned.	20 points
