- Record yourself presenting your speech this video will be shared on our social media platforms.

Judging:

Submissions will be judged using the following criteria.

Creative design, use of the Skills Canada BC logo, neat, colorful and visually appealing	Points
Captivated the audience, speaking clearly, paced and confidently.	Up to 5 points.
Stayed on topic, chose a Skill for success and made it clear.	Up to 10 points.
Submitted a video, memorized all or most of their speech.	Up to 15 points.
Total amount of points that can be earned.	30 points.
