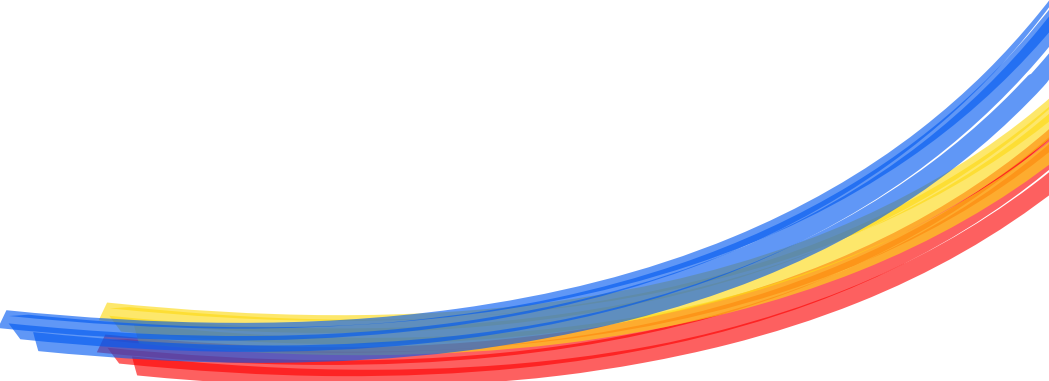

The In-School programs are available to be sponsored.

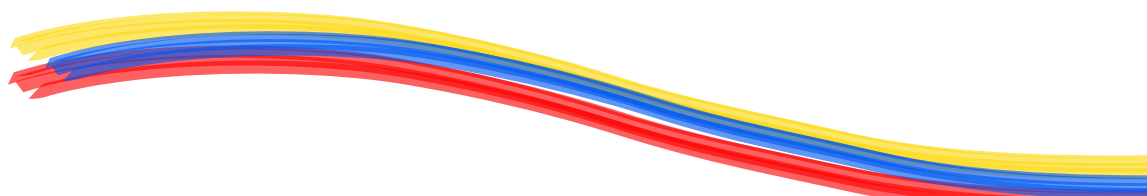

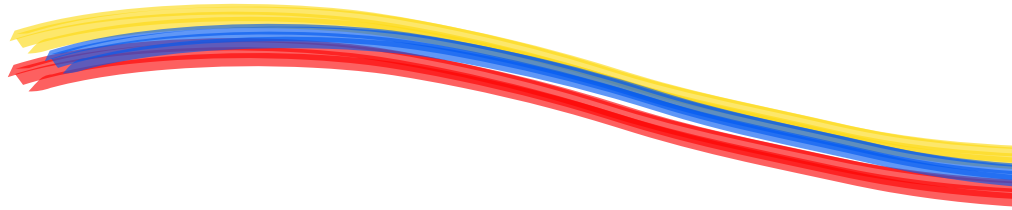
