CONTEST INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose of the Challenge

- Students are to demonstrate their overall ability and knowledge of Graphic Design. They must submit 1 LOGO/MASCOT and 1 PROMO POSTCARD DESIGN (2-sided) concept within the given time frame.

1.2 Time

- The competition will run for a maximum of 5 hours plus half hour for lunch (9am - 2:30pm)
Check in time 8:30.

1.3 Skills & Knowledge to be tested.

- Use of Graphic Design Programs
- Understanding of TEXT use and COLOUR use
- Creativity
- Understanding of layout and design concepts

1.4 Submissions

- Each competitor will create a folder with his/her name on it:

CONTEST DESCRIPTION

THEME: CHILDRENS FESTIVAL

THE BRIEF:

The Surrey International Children's Festival would like to introduce:

ELLY the Elephant. Our new mascot for the next five years of the Children's festival held at Bear Creek Park.

We would like you to design a GRAPHIC/MASCOT of 'ELLY' to use on multiple items (graphic material, buttons, Stickers, T Shirts, and other promotional items). The design should be simple, playful, and only contain 3 simple colours. This mascot will be placed somewhere on all materials used to promote the festival.

We also would like you to design a 5" X 7" POSTCARD to promote the festival. The postcard should be FULL colour for the front and include ELLY, and the festival name. Add any other fun items that you think should be included to make a colourful invitation to the event that represents Surrey.

For the back, again please use ELLY and add other information such as location and date. Also, for the back we would like it to be a duotone simplified concept with white and only one other colour (BLUE) be used. Remember you can use a variety of shades of BLUE. We will just be using one INK for the back.
