### **WorldSkills:**

- Delegate packages just sent by Skills Canada and will be reviewed. Payment due by May.
- Ongoing check-ins with Zachary and Angie, BC World Skills competitors
- Shoshawna did a site visit at Eric Hamber to touch base with trainer and expert and Angie. Progress going really well.
- Zachary training in China. Working for BCIT.

#### Sponsorship:

- Business Development Committee met Wednesday, March 20
- Sponsorship is currently at \$220,000 (have exceeded goal of \$200,000)
- Continued follow up with existing and potential new sponsors still in the pipeline but will wrap up soon.

  - We are in our 3<sup>rd</sup> year for funding from a 3-year funding cycle/agreement. Ends March 31, 2024
  - Sending March deliverable/report to STBC this week. \$40,000
  - o STBC will speak at Partner's Luncheon. Coordinating this.
- Government of Canada ESDC funding Mona and I are preparing and submitting ongoing quarterly reporting to Skills Canada.
