Skills Canada Board Meeting, May 15, 2024

Regionals:

Dates: February to April, 2024

Data: 1800+ (not including some Regionals which ran in classroom so no registration).

Provincials:

- April 17, 2024 at Tradex, Abbotsford
- Busy tying up loose ends, payments, subsidies etc.
- 60 competitions
- 500 competitors, increased from 300 competitors last year
- Estimated over 4000 spectators, suggest doubled from last year
- Over 60 school buses registered
- Debriefed with Tradex and the team
- More ideas have been discussed with Tradex for next year.
- Have booked a date with Tradex for Provincials for next year April 15, 2025

Nationals:

- Dates: May 29 to June 1 (competition dates are May 30 and 31).
- Location: Quebec City
- Status of the 2025 Skills Canada National Competition Regina Saskatchewan, not Ottawa as originally suggested. May 29 and 30 are competition dates.
- Nationals sent out hotels list for Regina 2025. Secured a hotel for Team BC. Royale Hotel Regina.
- Currently in the midst of Registration for competitors and delegates and sorting out agenda and logistics, hotel bookings etc.

WorldSkills:

- Visited Angie at Regionals in April Eric Hamber Secondary for a check-in. Angie also trained at Provincials space.

- Competing against Japan for this opportunity.
- World Skills organization representatives visited Toronto recently and apparently were impressed with the potential for Toronto.
- The group will determine if Canada can apply for a bid. This will be determined by the WorldSkills Board by May 11.
